BioThrax is a non-live anthrax vaccine which contains no infectious agents. This vaccine cannot cause anthrax disease.

Product Components:

BioThrax does not pose a physical or health hazard at the component percentages present in the product based on the guidelines established by the OSHA Hazard Communication Standard

Handling and Storage:

No special controls or personal protection equipment (PPE) required. Storage – BioThrax should be stored between 2°C to 8°C. DO NOT FREEZE. First Aid Measures: Eye Contact - In the event of accidental eye contact, flush eye with water for a minimum of 15 minutes. Skin Contact - In the event of accidental contact, wash with soap and water.

Fire-Fighting Measures:

There are no known fire or explosion hazards for BioThrax, although the cardboard packaging is combustible.
